Firm fined \$78,000 after quad bike rider's death...

A Bay of Plenty honey company which sent a novice worker on a quad bike **without a helmet** was fined \$78,000 after the man's death.

...The bike was found overturned on the farm driveway and the man, **who had no helmet**, was taken to Wellington Hospital, where he died from head injuries.

The Department of Labour regional workplace manager said rider inexperience, and the failure to wear an approved helmet, had killed a number of riders. He added that the lesson from this case is that farmers and other employers who use ATVs must ensure that their employees wear an approved ATV helmet.

Court fines farmer \$45,000...

The Palmerston North District Court fined a farmer a total of \$45,000 for failing to take all practicable steps to ensure the safety of an employee, after he suffered serious head injuries from a quad bike accident where he wasn't wearing a helmet.

Because the employee had not been wearing a helmet, the severity of his injuries increased as a consequence.

The Department of Labour Chief Advisor for Health and Safety said "This accident is a wakeup call to everyone involved with ATVs. The 'she'll be right' attitude just doesn't cut it."
